

FIRE PLANS AND PROCEDURES: If there is a fire in the building, or if the alarm sounds, do not panic, and do not assume the fire alarm is malfunctioning.

- A. If you are in your apartment, and there is a fire outside your door, or the fire alarm sounds:
 - 1. Do not open your apartment door without feeling it first to see if it is hot.
 - If the front door is hot, or smoke is leaking under it, DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR!
 a. Put a wet towel under the door, and make sure your door is unlocked.
 b. Crack a window, and sit by the window until a fireman comes.
- B. If you are in the common area, and there is a fire, or the fire alarm sounds:

1. If you are in the community room when the fire alarm sounds, exit the building through a safe passageway.

2. If you are in the hallway, and there is no sign of fire, enter your apartment, or ask to enter a neighbors apartment. Do not open a door without testing it first.

3. If the fire is in the hallway or common area, exit the building through a safe passageway.

- C. If a fire starts in your apartment:
 - 1. Do not hesitate to leave your apartment. Close the door behind you.
 - 2. Pull the fire alarm pull station nearest your apartment.
 - 3. Call 911 from a neighbor's phone and give them your name, address, and apartment number.
