Today's most widely used type of fire extinguisher is the multipurpose dry chemical that is effective on Class A, B and C fires. Class A fires are 'Ordinary Combustibles' such as <u>trash</u>, <u>wood</u>, and <u>paper</u>. Class B fires are 'Liquids' such as <u>gasoline</u>, <u>petroleum oil</u>, and <u>paint</u>. Class B fires can also involve 'Flammable Gases' such as <u>propane</u> and <u>butane</u>. Class C fires are 'Electrical Equipment' such as <u>motors</u>, <u>transformers</u>, and <u>appliances</u>.



Every unit at Norgard Court Apartments has a 'Dry Chemical' fire extinguisher, located in the pantry closet. Do take time to read the operating instructions and warnings found on the fire extinguisher label. Do not pull the pin or squeeze the lever. This will break the extinguisher seal and cause it to lose pressure. When it is time to use the extinguisher on a fire, just remember to P.A.S.S.! **PULL, AIM, SQUEEZE, SWEEP.**

Hold Upright - **PULL** ring pin Start back 8 feet - **AIM** at base of fire **SQUEEZE** lever - **SWEEP** side to side



Only fight a fire:

- A. If the fire is small and contained.
- B. If you are safe from toxic smoke.
- C. If you have a means of escape.
- D. If your instincts tell you it's okay.

THE RULES FOR FIGHTING FIRES – Just remember the three A's <u>ACTIVATE</u> the building alarm system or notify the fire department by calling 911. Or, have someone else do this for you.

<u>ASSIST</u> any persons in immediate danger, or those incapable on their own, to exit the building, without risk to yourself. Only after these two are completed should you <u>ATTEMPT</u> to extinguish the fire.
