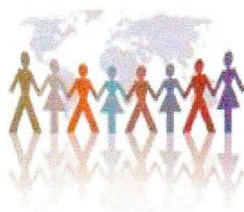
You Light Up My Life!

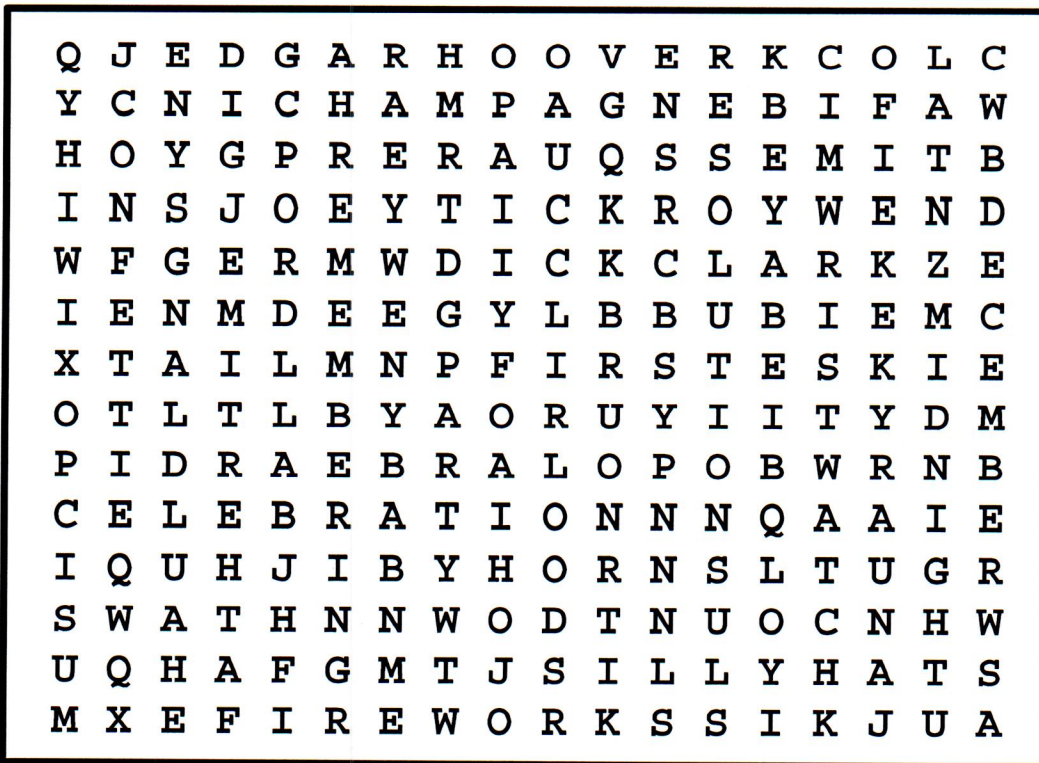
