## Dryer Tips.....

## Why You Need to Clean the Lint Filter Every Time

You've heard that you need to clean the dryer lint trap after every load, but is it true? Let's discuss the reasons to clean the lint filter, how often you should perform this task, and more useful tips.

#### Why Do You Clean a Dryer Lint Filter?

When clothing tumbles around in the dryer, the agitation and high heat cause clothing, towels, and linens to shed some of their fibers. The lint screen catches many of these fibers to prevent obstructing the dryer vent hose. It's important to clean this screen for several reasons:

- Keep your energy bills down: If the screen is clogged with a thick layer of lint, the dryer must work harder to perform its task, pushing your energy bills up. Cleaning the dryer lint screen allows more air to flow out the exhaust vent for efficient operation.
- Help your dryer last longer: Any time you can take pressure off the machine, you decrease overall wear and tear. This reduces the need for emergency repairs and helps the appliance last longer.
- Dry your clothes faster: Proper airflow is necessary to dry your clothes in a single cycle. If you continually have to add time to each batch, check the filter. It might be clogged with lint.
- Reduce the risk of fire: Dryers generate high temperatures, and lint is highly flammable. Remove this fire starter from your laundry room to help keep your home and family safe from dryer fires.

#### How Often Do You Clean a Lint Filter?

The recommendations you've heard are correct – you should clean the lint filter between every batch of clothes. Get into the habit of removing lint from the screen, either before or after every batch. Many new dryers will automatically remind you to check the lint filter before starting up.
